

What Can I Recycle?

Acceptable recyclable materials:

- Plastics with any number from 1 to 7 on the bottom (including wide-mouth containers such as margarine, yogurt, sour cream containers, empty plastic prescription bottles, plastic drinking cups)
- Rinsed juice and milk containers
- Empty aerosol cans
- Glass jars and bottles
- Aluminum, tin and steel food cans and foil
- Mixed paper (all colors, mail, books(hardback, paperback and text books), newsprint, folders, magazines, cardboard, cereal boxes (without the plastic bag liner), phone books)

Unacceptable materials:

- Plastic bags
- Dry cleaning bags
- Wire hangers
- Chemicals or paint
- Used paper napkins, towels plates and tissues
- Metallic wrapping paper
- Non-bottle or jar glass
- Window glass
- Used food containers and wax-lined boxes
- Foam or plastic packaging material
- Motor oil containers
- Bottles and cans used for toxic substances
