The 46<sup>th</sup> Legislative District Delegation thanks you for your support of the Locust Point Community Garden (LPCG), a treasured green space in Locust Point.

We have heard repeatedly how highly this space is prized by residents, current and aspiring gardeners, and visitors who appreciate its charm. The LPCG donates fresh vegetables to needy residents and supporting organizations in the area, hosts numerous events, and regularly collaborates with local schools and scouting organizations to educate young people on the benefits of eating fresh vegetables and preserving green space.

The LPCG has more than eighty members, including 10 Under Armour (UA) employees. The garden is actively growing to meet demand in the community. There are plans to add eighteen additional plots in 2023, an effort to serve more of the 30-person waiting list. Additionally, they recently had a mural painted to celebrate the beauty of our local flora.

We have heard from our constituents that there is uncertainty surrounding the garden’s future. We understand that as UA transitions out of the neighborhood, the plot which has been graciously provided for its use may be sold. We are writing to ask that you consider any alternative options which would preserve this space for the community as an enduring legacy from your time in Locust Point.

We believe this plot would be a fitting monument to UA’s presence in the community, and its ongoing commitment to Baltimore City as a whole.
