In 2025, the LPCA was proud to serve and support our community through a range of initiatives and events. We've genuinely enjoyed being of service and strengthening the connections that make our neighborhood so special. Here are a few highlights:

Community Grants Awarded

- **Community Tree Trimming Project** – \$2,750
 - Trimmed 15 trees to address a multi-year City backlog
- **Annual Holiday Parade** – \$1,000
- **Key Highway Civic Association** – Fort Ave / Key Highway Bridge under-lighting – \$1,000
- **U-Haul “Slightly Used Stuff” Donation Day** – \$150

Donations given to other Community Programs

- **FSK Annual Giving Campaign** – \$2,500

- **Holiday Party Toys for Tots**
 - \$590 in cash donations & a large box of new toys + **\$500 check from LPCA**

Events Hosted & Sponsored

- **April: Earth Day Park & Community Cleanup**
 - Included removal of large dead branches and stumps
- **May: SOBO Day Table Event**
 - Represented the LPCA at the 4th annual SoBo Day
- **September: Defenders Day Sponsorship at Fort McHenry**
 - Fireworks and free shuttle service from the LPCA Festival
- **September: Locust Point Festival**
 - Over **5,000 attendees** throughout day
 - **5 bands, 74 vendor tables, 6 Locust Point food stations**
 - **\$12,270 in revenue** generated for LPCA
- **October: Halloween Judging Contest**
- **October: Fall Park & Francis Scott Key (FSK) Grounds Cleanup**
- **December: Holiday Party**
 - Over 300 attendees
 - Special visit from Santa Claus

- **Various times of the year: Domino Factory Tours**
 - 4 community tours hosted
 - 42 total participants

Community Projects Completed

- **Street Banner Project**
 - Installed **34 community-designed banners**
- **Compost Program Expansion**
 - Added **13 new residents** to weekly pickup
- **Railroad Crossing Advocacy**
 - Successfully championed CSX repairs at Andre & Hull Streets
- **Tree Maintenance**
 - Mulching and care for trees planted near Fort McHenry
- **Latrobe Park Improvements**
 - Installed new volleyball posts and net

Advocacy, Committees & Task Forces

- **Design & Review Committee**
 - 20 community members that provided community input and feedback on the Cheer building and Tide Point projects.
 - Community-driven review of proposed townhouse development and Cristo Rey project
- **PUD Task Force**
 - Provided guidance and educated residents on the Planned Unit Development (PUD) process and restrictions related to Tide Point and Cheer building proposals
